

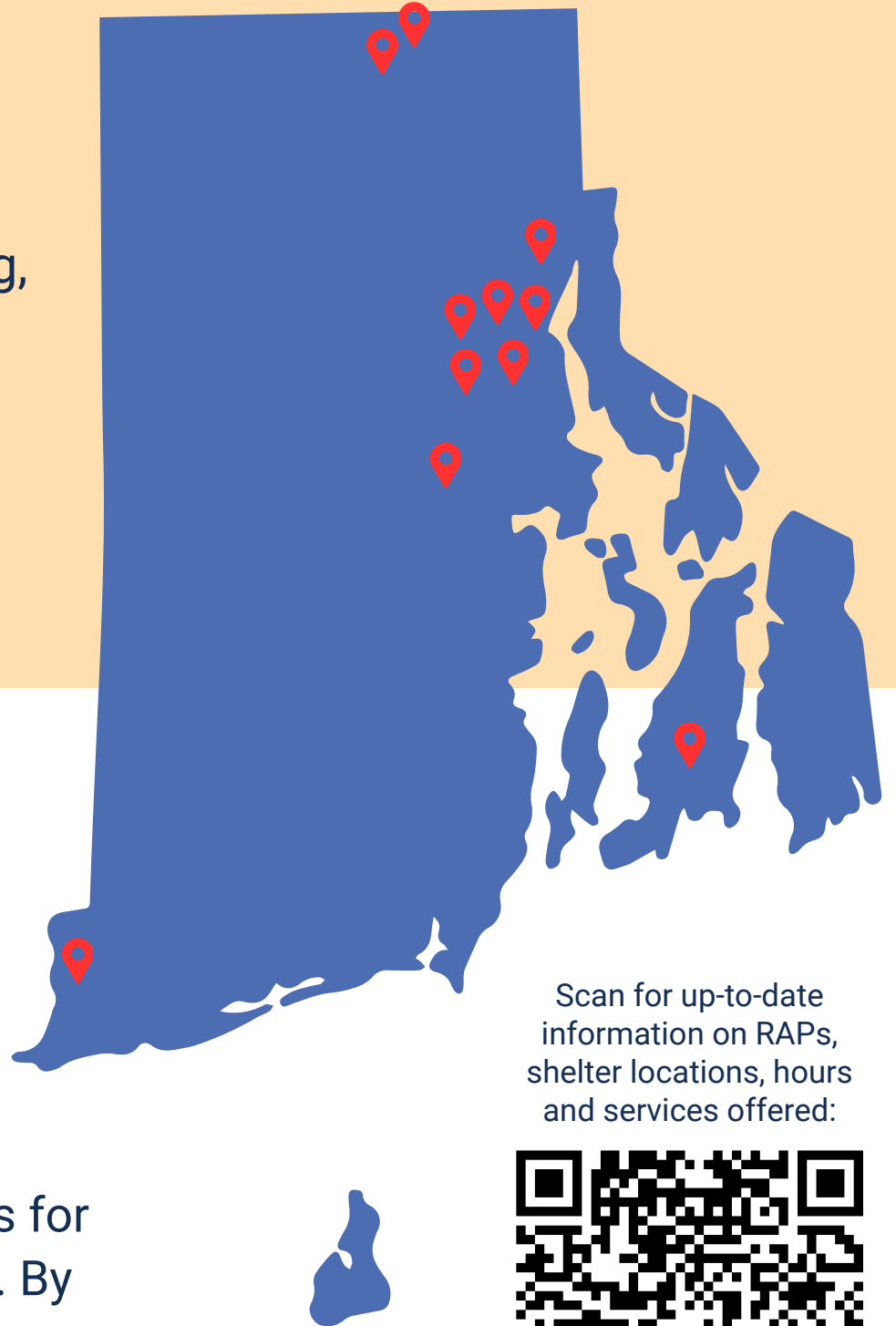


NOW OPEN: Regional Access Points (RAPs)



Rhode Island has a new process for individuals and households experiencing, or at risk of homelessness to seek emergency shelter and supportive services.

Regional Access Points (RAPs) are local entry points where individuals and families can begin the process of accessing housing, supportive services and emergency shelter. RAPs also offer prevention and diversion support, mental health and substance use services, and referrals to other critical resources.



Why RAPs?

RAPs are replacing the Coordinated Entry System, Rhode Island’s statewide homeless response system.

In the past, relying on a single phone line for homeless services created significant barriers for people seeking shelter or housing assistance. By establishing multiple Regional Access Points, the goal is for people to be able to connect quickly to resources with stronger local knowledge.

RAPs take a person-centered approach, prioritizing each individual’s unique needs, easing access to emergency shelter and services.
